South Tunnel Renovation:

A \$6.5 million renovation project for Bowling Green State University (BGSU) South Tunnel began in May of 2008. This project also included upgrades and renovation to the tunnel servicing points from the Centrex Building to the Harshman / Kreischer Residence Hall complex.

Project Duration: 10 Months

Project Cost: \$3.8 Million

General Project Scope:

The renovations included the replacement of the highly deteriorated tunnel tops and relocation of tunnel steam, condense mains. IPS pipe fitters increased the steam main to a size of 12 inches.

Challenges:

The primary challenge of the project was making sure the project and construction did not interfere with students due to closed parking lots and driveways, as well as steam replacement disruptions.
