Northwest State Community College is a public two-year college that is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The Applied Health Building was built in 1972 and houses the rapidly growing nursing program. The program's success is due to its 100% after graduation employment rating and above average testing scores. The construction of a new two story building on the south side of campus as well as renovations to the second floor of facility is necessary to meet the increase in enrollment.

General Project Scope

This project will be constructed in 2 phases over the course of two years. IPS is the prime plumbing contractor for the construction and renovations to the Applied Health Building Addition. IPS will be self performing underground piping associated with water closets, bathroom fixtures, bathroom facilities and drinking fountains.
