## *Mark Jefferson Laboratory*

The complex houses the College of Arts and Sciences, including biology, chemistry, physics and psychology, and the creation of this world-class facility is intended to help EMU leverage its cutting-edge science research and innovative teaching. The new layout will allow instructors to employ new interdisciplinary instructional methods, creating more interactive, technology-rich classroom environments and permitting student work to be more collaborative.

## *General Project Scope*

IPS is the preferred contractor for the HVAC and plumbing renovations at Mark Jefferson Laboratory on the campus of Eastern Michigan. IPS is installing chillers, pumps, air-handlers, heat exchangers and VAV's on the HVAC portion of the project. They are also responsible for the laboratory piping consisting of nitrogen, air, natural gas, reverse osmosis water, domestic water, sanitary piping and storm drain piping. This is a LEED Silver certified project featuring green design elements including sunscreens, bioswales and low-volume flush-valves. The project is delivered through a lump sum contract.
