In October 1946, Soichiro Honda established the Honda Technical Research Institute in Hamamatsu, Japan, to develop and produce small 2-cycle motorbike engines. Two years later, Honda Motor Company, Ltd. was born. In 1959, American Honda Motor Co., Inc. proudly opened its doors with a small storefront in Los Angeles, CA. Honda has been a major contributor to the U.S. economy for more than 45 years. Today, Honda employs more than 25,000 people in all 50 states.

Project Scope

As the General Contractor for this project, IPS was responsible for all facets of the project from excavating and pouring concrete to the architectural work such as; block, pre-insulated siding, roofing and painting. Included was fabrication and erection of the structural steel, furnish, and install exterior batch tanks with mezzanine steel and mixers, and furnish and install process equipment such as; settlers, filter press, chemical tanks, pumps and polymer systems. With this turn-key project IPS executed all of the electrical, HVAC, controls, and equipment installation.
