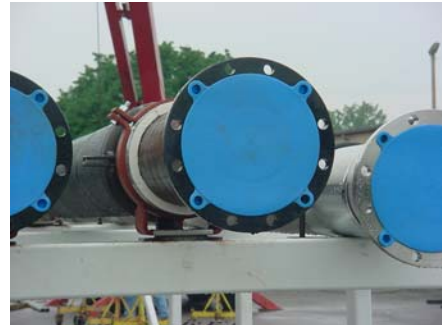
General Project Scope

IPS assisted designer, Matric Technologies, by verifying dimensions on utility racks. IPS used Matrix Technologies to verify that the design was consistent with the field observations and Matrix made CAD drawings for the fabrication. Based on these drawings, IPS fabricated the steel and pipe headers in our fab shop and shipped the fabricated utility headers to Lordstown. IPS installed the headers onsite. In addition to the utility header fabrication and installation, IPS set pumps, installed cooling water pool, chilled water, hot water heat, gasoline and diesel fuel, piping systems and performed Time and Material work to support the project's completion.
