

Husky Energy (Premcor) Refinery

Design . Bid . Build • Lima, Ohio

CGHT Project:

Husky Energy now owns what was previously known as Premcor Refinery in Lima, Ohio when IPS performed work at the site. Premcor was a Fortune 500 oil refinery group based in Greenwich, Connecticut. It operated four refineries, which are located in Port Arthur, Texas; Memphis, Tennessee; Lima, Ohio; and Delaware City, Delaware with a combined crude oil volume processing capacity of approximately 768,120 barrels per day (July, 2007). Premcor was acquired by Valero in 2005 and was later sold to Husky Energy in July 2007.



Project Scope:

IPS was the General Contractor responsible for the construction of the Cat Gas Hydro-Treater project. IPS self-performed all piping and electrical work. All equipment and module installation including towers, exchangers, heaters and subcontracted all site, civil and structural work. Since the project was designed concurrent with the construction, IPS worked closely with the design firm, CBI, Inc., to ensure that construction and design could proceed in a logical, timely and cost effective manner. The project schedule was maintained through a cooperative approach at the project team level with an eye toward solving problems in the field prior to their occurrence. However, when problems were identified in the field they were immediately attacked and solved. There were "end of job surprises" on this project.
